In our project, an online meeting will be held with all participants 1 week before the mobility date.


Attendance at the meeting is mandatory.

What do you need?

Health Insurance Certificate: A valid health insurance policy for the duration of the project.

HEALTH INSURANCE IS NOT PROVIDED AND THE PROJECT GRANT WILL NOT BE REFUNDABLE, ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST PURCHASE PRIVATE TRAVEL INSURANCE.

Health insurance must meet the following criteria:

- Comprehensive Coverage: The insurance must provide comprehensive coverage for medical emergencies, accidents and illnesses that may occur during the program.
- Repatriation Coverage: The insurance must provide repatriation coverage in the event that the participant needs to be repatriated to their home country for medical attention.
- Emergency assistance
- Pre-existing conditions

Participants with specific dietary requirements, intolerances, allergies or other eating habits must notify the host organization at least one week prior to arrival so that options can be discussed with the hotel and meals can be rearranged. Information received after this date cannot be taken into account regarding participants' meals and menus. It is important to state your dietary habits, allergies, intolerances and medical conditions in the application form. Participants should recommend any necessary medications they use or think they need to use daily during the project.

What to bring:

Comfortable Clothing: Suitable clothing for walking and outdoor activities.

Personal Hygiene Products: Please bring personal care products, slippers and towels that you may need during your stay at the hotel. Digital Devices: Laptop, tablet or mobile phone for presentations and events.

Reimbursement

Within the scope of the project, accommodation, food and event costs will be covered by the Erasmus+ program. Transportation costs will be reimbursed within the project budget. For the reimbursement of transportation expenses, you must keep the original tickets and receipts.

Don't buy your tickets without confirmation from the project coordinator. (Tickets that are bought without confirmation will not be reimbursed.) Tickets purchased without the approval of the Project Coordinator will not be considered valid and participants will be excluded from the project. This is a very important rule.

Do not use a taxi or private car, it is not an eligible cost, in case there are other options. Never lose your boarding cards, e-tickets, invoices, and bus/train tickets, you will need your tickets for reimbursement. Travel plans that are not approved by us or purchased from a travel agency and online platform such as *skyscanner*, *esky*, *kiwi* or others will not be refunded. Please take only your travel tickets from the official website of the carrier.

All attendees should note that this is a European project funded by the European Commission and the cheapest and most environmentally friendly travel routes will be considered for the participants' journey. The purchase of additional services such as seat, meals on board, automatic check-in, excess baggage, late arrival at the gate and other services not included in the standard ticket price will not be reimbursed.

At least %80 attendance of activities is important to get reimbursement. All tickets MUST be presented in original. Photos of tickets or scanned copies will not be refunded.

Important Information and Rules

Participants should participate in the activities on time and actively. The photos and videos taken during the project will be used for Erasmus+ dissemination activities. If you have any objections about this, please contact the organizers.



Those who violate the established rules of the project, harass others, undermine the prestige of the organization or commit systematic violations of the established norms will be excluded from the project. The sending organisation will be informed of this by email with details of the case and the specific reasons for removal.

Dissemination

Dissemination is an important part of any Erasmus+ funded project. The European Commission invests in you as a community leader, a change maker, so each of us is responsible for giving back and sharing the positive experience among our network, so that at least one newcomer can discover Erasmus+ opportunities.

Each participant (country group) is responsible for:

Article: Young people will prepare an article with photos that will be used by the news reporter to shape the general publication. Each partner organization will organize information meetings for youth workers in their country to introduce the training materials and guidelines developed in the project. At international events such as Erasmus Days, participants and local youth groups will come together to share project experiences and results, thus ensuring that project outputs reach a wider audience.

Website: Participants with graphic design skills will help us shape the appearance of the website.

Social networks: Daily reports, photo material, measurable achievements and uploading useful resources will be managed by the project participants, who will design and edit the news stories themselves.

Videos: Participants will upload videos, interviews and post daily vlogs of what happened during the implementation, taking turns. They will invite their friends and acquaintances to follow the channel to stay up to date. Through innovative tools such as digital storytelling, video interviews, podcast series, Instagram live streams and TikTok videos, the participants will make the project engaging for both young people and the wider society and ensure effective dissemination of the project message.

Workshop: After returning to their country, participants will attend at least one event. Delivery of the survey from the European Commission. After the project, participants will serve as "Environmental Ambassadors" in their local communities. This role will encourage participants to organize awareness-raising and awareness-raising activities in their communities by giving them the responsibility to transfer what they have learned and gained from the project to their environment. Participants will organize workshops and interactive presentations at local schools, youth centers and community gatherings on topics such as environmental sustainability and responsible use of AI. Host and partner organizations will assist and guide participants as needed.
